

### **BECAUSE SEWANEE OFFERS A** RIGOROUS ACADEMIC EXPERIENCE.

WITH A STUDENT-TO-PROFESSOR RATIO OF 10:1 AND AN AVERAGE CLASS SIZE OF 17, ALL OF OUR MORE THAN **160** FULL-TIME FACULTY MEMBERS (96% HAVE TERMINAL DEGREES IN THEIR FIELDS) REALLY KNOW US.

We offer 38 majors, 44 minors, three certificate programs (CIVIC AND **GLOBAL LEADERSHIP, CREATIVE WRITING, AND WATER-**SHED SCIENCE), and five pre-professional programs (BUSINESS, **EDUCATION, ENGINEERING, LAW, MEDICAL AND HEALTH** PROFESSIONS). 60% OF US MAJOR AND MINOR, and 14% OF **US DOUBLE MAJOR**. That 14% is particularly impressive when you consider that 100% of us take comprehensive examinations in our majors (If you double major, you take two).

AMONG SEWANEE'S MOST POPULAR MAJORS ARE BIOLOGY, ECONOMICS, ENGLISH, HISTORY, INTERNATIONAL AND GLOBAL STUDIES, NATURAL RESOURCES AND THE ENVIRONMENT, POLITICS, AND PSYCHOLOGY.


#### FINDING YOUR PLACE =
