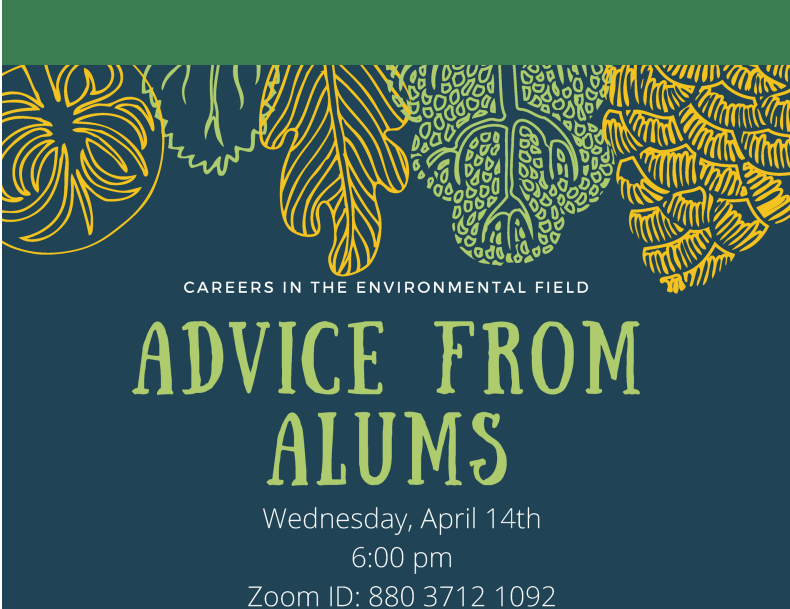

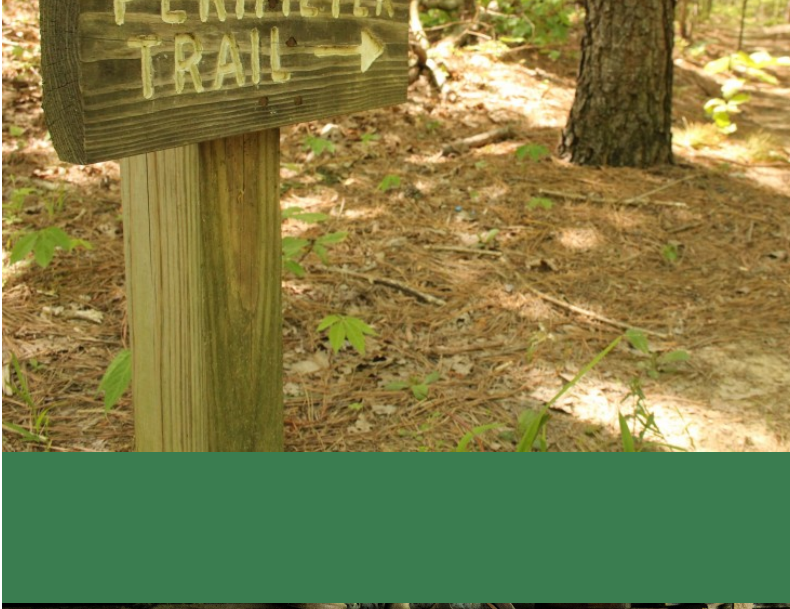

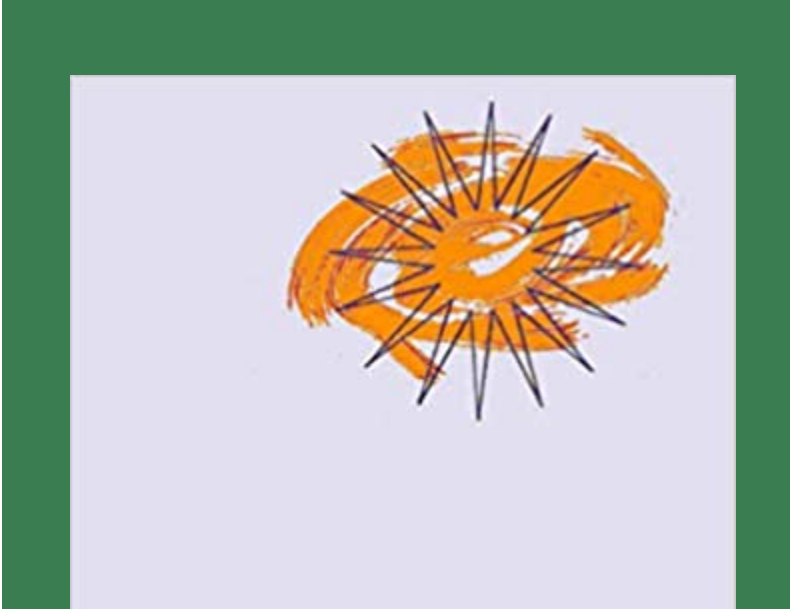

This new edition will be available for purchase in the Sewanee bookstore by Earth Day.



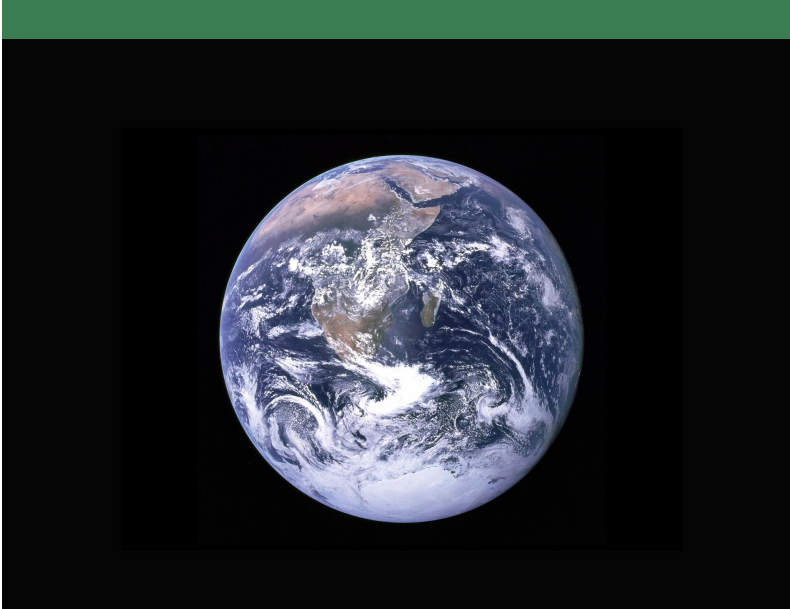
