* FINC 201 and FINC 301 should be taken no later than the semester indicated. However, students may find it beneficial to take these courses earlier, especially if they are interested in pursuing internships in finance between their sophomore and junior years. ECON 101 is a prerequisite to FINC 201. The prerequisites to FINC 301 are FINC 201, STAT 204 and BUSI 215.

**ECON 233 or STAT 214 must be completed before taking FINC 410. If chosen, ECON 233 may be taken at any point up to the fall of the senior year. ECON 120 and ECON 133 are prerequisites to ECON 233. CSCI 157 is recommended prior to this course. STAT 204 & CSCI 157 are prerequisites to STAT 214. STAT 214 is offered only in spring semesters and thus should be taken in the spring of the junior year if this alternative is selected. However, you should be aware that STAT 214 may not be offered every spring.

[†] LANG and G6 (or G6XX) courses will be taken in a single foreign language of the student's choice. This plan assumes that students are beginners in foreign language education. Those with language experience in high school may place into higher-level foreign language courses. College general education requirements are: *One 300-level or higher foreign language course OR foreign language through the 200 (3rd semester) level together with one course in a related culture.*
