## Holiday Residence Hall Schedule



Instructions for checking out of the residence halls or houses at the end of the semester were sent to your student. They are below.

All residence halls and houses close at 10 a.m. on Friday, Dec. 15, 2023.

Students must have packed and removed all needed belongings and exited their residence by this deadline. There is no formal checkout process with a staff member-just review the below steps to ensure that you properly prepare your room for the break and **avoid any December closing fines**. Once you are packed and your room is ready, simply depart campus and travel safely to your winter break destination.

**Checkout Overview** 

Follow these steps to be sure you are properly prepared for the winter break.

Take ALL valuable items and anything you will need during the winter break (e.g. books or study materials, medications, passport, credit cards, etc.). Due to decreased staff presence and the closure of the University over the break period, the University will be unable to provide you with access to your room and is unable to retrieve and ship anything you forget.

Bring your room key with you. ALL rooms will be inspected AND LOCKED after your departure. You will need your room key upon your return in January to access your room and avoid a lockout fine. Please contact Residential Life as soon as possible if you have lost your room key.

In leaving items behind in your room, you recognize that the University bears no responsibility for damage or theft to any of your belongings. Please remember that damage and/or theft remain possibilities over the extended winter break, and that the University will not provide additional security for belongings left in campus residences.

Unplug AND defrost all personal refrigerators. This will take at least 24 hours to complete, so be sure to empty your refrigerator of all contents, unplug it, and lay a towel at the door to collect any melting ice without damaging the floor of your room. Failure to do this will result in a \$50 fine.

Remove ALL trash and recycling from your room and place it in the proper receptacles. There will be a \$35 fine if staff have to dispose of trash on your behalf.

Unplug ALL electronics left in your room. Help us avoid all potential issues and responsibly manage campus energy usage by unplugging all items from all wall sockets.

If you plan to leave your vehicle on campus, please park it in the large lot on Kentucky Avenue near Gorgas Hall. Ensure there are no visible valuables, and that your vehicle is secure before departing.

Secure your bicycle to the nearest bicycle rack or in your room. Be sure any bikes left in your room do not block doors or prevent egress.

Secure your room before you depart. Close and lock all windows, lower and shut all blinds, turn off the lights, and lock the door behind you before you depart.

Complete your Express Check Out form. Once the form is completed successfully, you will receive an email to confirm your submission. Failure to complete this form will result in a \$50 fine.

### **Returning in January**

Residence halls and houses will reopen at 9 a.m. on Sunday, Jan. 14, 2023. All students needing to come back to campus early, including students who are a part of an approved university program (Basketball, Swimming & Diving, Wildland Fire Training, Beyond the Gates, comping, etc.) will need to submit the Early Arrival Request form. The form will open on Dec. 1 and will close on Jan. 2. Please visit your <a href="Student Housing Portal">Student Housing Portal</a> to submit your request. Note: Approval is not guaranteed, and students may NOT return early without written permission in the form of an approval message from the Office of Residential Life.

Note: All new and returning housing assignments for the spring semester will be visible in your student housing portal on Jan. 11, 2024.

Not Returning in January

If you will not return in January (e.g. due to study abroad, early graduation, a leave of absence, etc.), you must take ALL personal belongings with you and fill out the Express Check Out form in your Student Portal.
