GRADUATE AND PROFESSIONAL SCHOOL ADMISSION

- Graduate and professional school admission representatives frequent our campus, and an expert on the graduate admission process and writing personal essays visits campus annually.
- Staff members provide support for students throughout the application process.
- Sewanee boasts high rates of acceptance in programs for law and health professions, and our students regularly are accepted to their top-choice master's and doctorate programs. Average acceptance rates: business, 90–95%; law, 90–95%; medicine, 80–85% (compared to the national average of 42%).

- We collaborate with Sewanee's pre-professional programs and advisors in business, education, engineering, law, and medical and health.
- Faculty invite us to present to individual classes and to provide content for their majors. Student organizations partner with us to co-sponsor events for their members and for the broader campus community.
