SEWANEE ATHLETICS: IMMEDIATE FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES

Exciting updates to the Fowler Center have generated momentum for additional improvements to Sewanee's athletic program. To enrich the student-athlete experience and ensure the safety and well-being of current and future Tigers, the University is seeking support for a selection of critical projects.

s Tiger alumni and current student-athletes know well, the University's athletic program isn't a supplement to the Sewanee experience—it's an integral part of campus life. Each year, dedicated Sewanee families, friends, and fans travel to the Mountain to watch our 24 varsity teams compete with teams from top Division III universities from across the country. Our student-athletes devote long hours each week to practice and play, and they deserve top-quality athletic spaces and facilities. The University has identified multiple opportunities to better serve our Tigers, and we now seek donor partnerships to bring these projects to fruition.

TURF REPLACEMENT

Sewanee is in critical need of turf replacement on Hardee-McGee Field (football and men's lacrosse) and Puett Field (field hockey, women's lacrosse, and men's and women's soccer). Turf on both of these fields has surpassed average turf lifespan by two to four years. Installing new turf is currently the University's highest athletic priority, on par with Fowler Center renovations.



OUTDOOR TRACK RESURFACING

Located at Hardee-McGee Field, Sewanee's Coughlan Track is home to the University's men's and women's track and field teams. Like our turf fields, the eight-lane, polyurethane track is showing signs of age and requires renovation. In order to maximize safety, ensure durability, and protect against water damage, the University seeks to fully resurface the track.

UPGRADES TO SOFTBALL AND BASEBALL FIELDS

Sewanee's Tiger Field and Montgomery Field, where our softball and baseball teams practice and play, are due for a number of upgrades. Installing additional lighting on both fields will improve safety and allow for greater flexibility in practice and game scheduling. Tiger Field is also in need of permanent seating, and Montgomery Field requires a new scoreboard.

CLARKE FIELD STORAGE SHED RENOVATION

Sewanee Athletics maintains an essential storage facility at Clarke Field, housing football, softball, and baseball equipment throughout the year. To guard against weather damage, the space requires a new roof, siding, and garage doors.

Implementing these changes will not only improve our student-athletes' time on the Mountain, but it will also provide major momentum to the University's athletic recruitment efforts. Donor generosity will be instrumental in driving the Tigers' next winning season.
