3. Make a gift of the full amount associated with your selected option. (Pledges can be made but must be honored in full before the recognition piece is ordered.)
4. Review and approve plaque language.
5. Please allow up to eight months for bench installation and up to six weeks for All Saints' Chapel chair plaque installation.

## ARCHED METAL BENCH BY MCGEE FIELD

*Donation of \$7,500*

- Bench with classic arched design featuring Sewanee's gothic S logo, placed on a landscaped footpath leading to the University's football field.
- Weather-resistant powder-coated quarter-inch rolled steel construction.
- Six feet in length, mounted on a concrete pad.
- 7.5- by 5-inch cast bronze plaque with standard engraving.



## ALL SAINTS' CHAPEL CHAIR PLAQUE

*Donation of \$2,000*

- Cast bronze commemorative plaque with standard language placed on back of All Saints' Chapel chair.
- Gift supports the ministry of All Saints' Chapel, including chapel programs and building preservation.
