How will there be enough accommodations for everyone?

We know that even in normal years, it can be tricky to secure accommodations for big weekends. We hope sharing the new date with you now will allow you time to find a place to stay. Sewanee Inn rooms will not be available since they will be saved for the 50th Reunion class members and our reunion award winners.

Many homeowners in Sewanee rent their homes or apartments and use <u>Airbnb</u> or <u>VRBO</u> to list them. You will be able to search availability that way and see pricing.

Finally, the alumni office keeps an <u>accommodation list</u> of homes/apartments that people rent in the area. Unfortunately, it is just a list and you can't see availability or pricing, but is a more comprehensive list than Airbnb or VRBO.

Don't forget about the hotels in Monteagle and the <u>Monteagle Assembly</u> (which will not be in season in November). There is a <u>new tiny home community</u> in Monteagle with many rental options. Also, <u>St. Mary's Retreat Center</u> and <u>Dubose Conference Center</u> offer options for rooms as well.

Will it be possible for all the classes to have their own reunion parties?
